

Copyright Policy

This Copyright Policy outlines the ownership of content on this Site, the responsibilities of users, and the procedures for addressing copyright-related concerns.

Responsibility for Your Content

1. You are solely responsible for the content you submit, post, upload, or otherwise transmit through the Site (“User Content”).
2. By using this Site, you agree to indemnify and hold harmless Music Nepal, its affiliates, officers, directors, employees, and agents from any claim, loss, liability, or expense arising out of your User Content, including claims of copyright or intellectual property infringement.

 - Your name, address, email, and contact information.
 - A description of the copyrighted work you claim has been infringed.

- A description of where the infringing material is located on the Site (with a URL, if applicable).
 - A statement that you have a good faith belief that the disputed use is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent, or the law.
 - A statement, made under penalty of perjury, that the information in your notice is accurate and that you are the copyright owner or authorized to act on behalf of the copyright owner.
 - Your physical or electronic signature.
